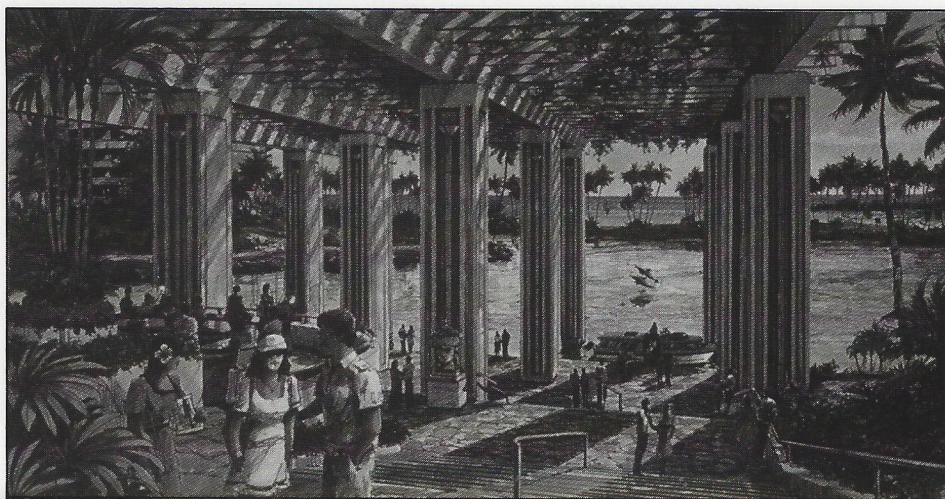
The resort will also offer eight tennis courts, as well as state-of-the-art exercise equipment, saunas, jacuzzis, aerobics, racquetball and squash.

The Big Island is the world's premier deep-sea fishing ground for the Pacific blue marlin. Deep-sea fishing charters are available nearby, as are catamaran cruises, scuba diving, helicopter tours and riding stables.

Many off-site activities will be available such as: hunting exotic game in tropical rain forests, tours to local artists' studios, or attending an actual cattle round-up on the famous Parker Ranch, with a real paniolo barbecue afterward.

Hyatt Regency Waikoloa Launches New Age in Fantasy Resorts

When the Hyatt Regency Waikoloa opens this fall, it promises to be more than just the most expensive resort ever built; its unique brand of Polynesian opulence will redefine the phrase "Fantasy Resort" forever.

With a \$360 million price tag, this spectacular resort carved out of 62 acres of jagged lava at the mouth of Wailua Bay on the Big Island will feature 1,244 guest rooms — 75% with ocean views — in three low-rise towers.

Guests will arrive at the resort's main lobby where towering colonnades frame a sweeping ocean view, and an expansive \$2 million

pink flagstone stairway, which will descend into a huge salt-water lagoon teeming with tropical fish and providing a home for tame dolphins.

Sleek canal boats will ferry guests through over a mile of waterways to their rooms, or they may choose to ride one of two air-conditioned, space-age tubular trams or stroll a mile-long museum walkway filled with \$3 million in Oriental and Pacific art.

Central to the resort will be a four-acre beach lagoon designed for swimming and snorkeling. A free-form swimming pool of nearly an acre will have its own waterfalls,
