

Frakes Gets FFA Award For Safety

LOS ANGELES—J. Fred Frakes, president of Frakes Aviation, Inc., Angwin, has been named the California winner of the Federal Aviation Administration's annual Aviation Mechanic Safety Award.

The awards—one in each state—are given to the aviation mechanic making the outstanding contribution to air safety by maintenance practice.

The winner in Arizona was Richard E. Packard, vice president of Operations Aviation Specialties, Inc., Mesa, Ariz. and the winner in Nevada was Robert A. Hecht, service manager of the Hughes Tool Co. repair station, Las Vegas, Nev.
