



### TERRENCE F. FLAHIFF

Election of Terrence E. Flahiff as President of the Manicouagan Power Company has been announced by Arthur A. Schmon, Chairman of the Board. Mr. Flahiff is Vice President of Quebec North Shore Paper Company, and Vice President of The Ontario Paper Company Limited. He is also a Director of Canadian British Aluminium Company Limited. The Manicouagan Power Company, with head office in Montreal, has its power development at the First Falls of the Manicouagan River, on the north shore of the St. Lawrence River, 250 miles east of Quebec City. Mr. Flahiff graduated in law at Osgoode Hall and was called to the Bar of Ontario in 1938. As an officer of the Irish Regiment of Canada and the Canadian Armoured Corps, Mr. Flahiff served through World War II, attaining the rank of Brigadier. On the termination of hostilities he became Coordinator of Housing for Canada and Federal Timber Controller, then joined Quebec North Shore Paper Company and The Ontario Paper Company Limited in 1947 as Assistant to the President.

Mr. Flahiff is married to the former Françoise Sévigny of Quebec, daughter of the late Chief Justice Albert Sévigny. They have two sons.
