USS O'KANE

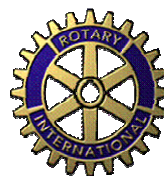

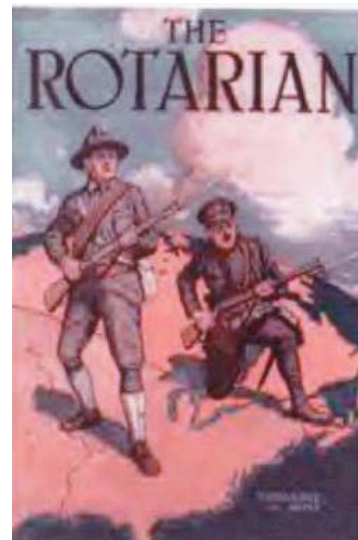
