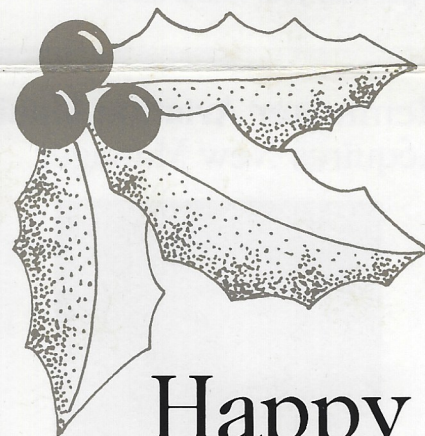

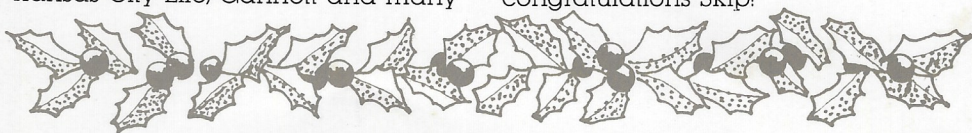
Happy Holidays Ahead!

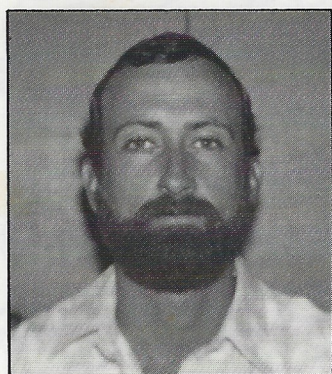
