


NEW CRUISER TANK FOR BRITISH FORCES



Pictured above is a new crusader cruiser tank which has particular interest to Montreal because it was donated to the British Army by Major Andrew P. Holt, son of Sir Herbert Holt. The General on top of the tank is the General Officer Commanding one of the British armored divisions, his name being withheld in the official release.

Major Holt, who is standing beside him, is now on the staff of the Ministry of Supply, which he joined recently, after serving in the Ministry of Aircraft Production. It will be noted that the tank had not been fully armed at the time the picture was taken, but it is now known that this, and many other of the same type of tank, are ready for service with the British forces wherever they may be needed.
