Dear Mick,

We appreciate your interest in our projected S-25 operation in Ireland this summer.

Revenue flights will be limited to operations in the Republic of Ireland.

We expect to be operating under lease to Aer Arann Ltd., utilizing our flying boat crews. Inquiries should be made to James Coen, General Manager, Aer Arann, Ltd., Dominick St., Galway, County Galway, Ireland.

The aircraft carries 42 passengers, and needs to have in excess of 30 passengers to offer a reasonable rate per passenger, based on approximately \$1000.00 U.S. per flying hour which is not a profitable figure for the small utilization we'll get this summer.

We expect to arrive in Foynes the morning of July 8, and will be based in Glengarriff Cove, off Bantry Bay, at least part of the time during our approximate two month stay. Our phone contact in Glengarriff, County Cork will be Glengarriff 4.
